

EBWT Divisions & Levels

EBWT offers four divisions, and various skill levels within each division:

18+ Division — Levels A1 to C

50+ Division — Levels A1 to B3

65+ Division — One level

Singles Division — One level

Teams with 4.0 members must register for an A level team. Teams that won their level the previous year must register for the next level up the following year.

To help ensure fair play, EBWT players are asked to select a level that matches their skills and abilities. This also applies to captains who recruit players to their teams. Be honest and use your best judgment. Players may compete above their skill level, but not below.

EBWT's levels are loosely based on the USTA rating system. Players that don't have a USTA rating can [review these descriptions](#) to help determine their rating/appropriate level of play. Below are guidelines for EBWT levels and their corresponding USTA ratings:

18+ and 50+ Divisions

A1: 4.5-5.0

A2: 4.0-4.5

A3: 3.5-4.0

B1: 3.0-3.5

B2: 3.0

B3: 2.5-3.0

C: Beginners

Singles Division

One level: 2.5-4.5

65+ Division

One level: 3.0-4.5
